ORDINANCE NO. 2016-08

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING VARIOUS SECTIONS OF CHAPTER XIX (TRAFFIC) OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF BELMAR

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Borough of Belmar, County of Monmouth, New Jersey, that Chapter XIX Traffic, of the Borough of Belmar Revised General Ordinances is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

SECTION I. 19-46.2 Handicapped Parking Limited to Specific Persons in Front of Certain Residences.

SECTION II. 19-14 PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES ON CERTAIN STREETS.

SECTION III. 19-39.1 Designated Taxicab Stands.

b. From 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. the following areas shall be used only by taxicabs which have not been issued a Belmar Taxicab License:

8. Sixteenth Avenue, south side, beginning at Main Street and continuing west to Railroad Avenue

9. Eighth Avenue, south side, beginning at Plaza Entrance and continuing west to Railroad Avenue

SECTION IV. 19-12 Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets.

SECTION IV. If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the section, paragraph, subdivision, clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the Ordinance shall be deemed valid and effective.

SECTION V. All Ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with or in conflict with the ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION VI. This Ordinance shall take effect 20 days after final passage, adoption and publication according to law.
