WHEREAS, October 2018 marks the 34th Anniversary of National Breast Cancer Awareness Month, which is dedicated to increasing awareness of breast cancer issues, especially the importance of early detection; and

2. Storage lockers, Seniors, for seasonal rental
(Friday prior to Memorial Day through September 15)
payable at the time of agreement execution for individuals who rented a storage locker during the 2018 Season and were sixty-two (62) years of age or older at any time during the 2018 Season and are renewing their storage locker rental for the 2019 Season.
Annual rental fee:.....\$150.00
