


Pollen

Tree pollen counts are usually highest from March to mid-May. Pollen is a very fine powder that is transported from plant to plant by the wind, birds, insects or other animals.



Trees produce light, dry pollen that can be carried by the wind for miles.

Wind allows pollen particles to float freely through the air.

Each species of tree produces its own type of pollen.

Grass pollen usually emerges in early May and continues through the end of June.
