Local Artist Wins International Acclaim

Designer of Belmar Logo Honored by the International Academy of Arts, Sciences and Letters

The International Academy of Arts, Sciences and Letters in Paris awarded Belmar resident Suzanne Anan a medal honoring her for the body of paintings she has created over the last ten years, along with an honorary diploma.

This year, Suzanne was the Artist in Residence at the legendary artist Georgia O'Keeffe's Ghost Ranch in New Mexico. While there, she created a portrait of her mother entitled "Friendship's Kiss," which was on display with the Monmouth Arts Charles Sills Memorial Group Art Exhibition in Long Branch. Another commissioned painting is in the private collection of Sir Paul McCartney and Nancy Shevell in Sussex, England.

Suzanne, who has shown her work all over the world, including in Italy, France, Ireland, Monaco, Spain and Japan, might be best known to Belmar residents as the artist who designed Belmar's wave logo. As a member of the Belmar Woman's Club, she designed its logo as well.

Suzanne has lived in Belmar, NJ with her family for over twenty years.
