Severe weather possible this evening into tonight

There will be a chance of severe thunderstorms late this afternoon into tonight. Here are some key messages regarding this potential:

- 1.) The threat of severe thunderstorms is highest over southern portions of our area, with the highest threat currently predicted to be near and south of the Philadelphia area.
- 2.) The primary severe-weather hazards will be damaging wind gusts and large hail.
- 3.) Two rounds of severe storms are possible at this time, with the first of these rounds expected early this evening through about midnight. After a brief lull, another round of storms will be possible in the pre-dawn hours Wednesday morning with storms forecast to move offshore around or shortly after daybreak.
